Information on the Annual General Meeting on 24 June 2026

During the planning and implementation of the event, numerous measures are being taken to comply with the standards of the Austrian Ecolabel for Green Meetings. The most important measures are as follows:

- We kindly ask you to use environmentally friendly means of transportation.
- The event will be organized in an environmentally friendly way (energy and waste management, procurement, materials).
- The catering provided includes mainly local and environmentally friendly products and attention is paid to organic quality.
- No plastic bottles or disposable capsules are used.
- Printing is avoided as far as possible.
- We do not use decorations or flower arrangements.
